#### THE WORD

#### **FIRST LESSON**

Deuteronomy 10:12-22

<sup>12</sup> So now, Israel, what is the LORD your God asking of you but to fear the LORD your God, to walk in all his ways, and to love him and to serve the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul, <sup>13</sup> to keep the commandments of the LORD and his statutes that I am commanding you today for your own good.

<sup>14</sup> Indeed, the heavens and the heaven of heavens, <sup>[a]</sup> the earth and everything that is on it—these belong to the LORD your God. <sup>15</sup> Still, the LORD attached himself to your fathers, loved them, and he chose their descendants after them (that's you!) from all peoples, as it is today.

<sup>16</sup> So cut away the tough shell of your sinful nature, and do not be stubborn any longer.

<sup>17</sup>The LORD your God is God of Gods and Lord of Lords, the great God, the mighty one and the awesome one, who does not show favoritism and does not take a bribe. <sup>18</sup> He carries out justice for the fatherless and widows. He loves the alien who dwells among you and gives him food and clothing. <sup>19</sup> So you are to love the alien, because you were aliens in the land of Egypt.

<sup>20</sup> Fear the LORD your God, serve him, cling to him, and take your oaths in his name.

<sup>21</sup> He is your glory. He is your God, who performed for you these great and awesome things that your own eyes have seen.

<sup>22</sup> When your fathers went down to Egypt, they numbered seventy people, but now the LORD your God has made you as numerous as the stars of the sky.

SECOND LESSON 1 John 2:15-17

<sup>15</sup> Do not love the world or the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him. <sup>16</sup> For everything in the world—the lust of the flesh, the desire of the eyes, boasting about material possessions—is not from the Father but from the world. <sup>17</sup> The world and its desires pass away, but the one who does the will of God remains forever.

THE GOSPEL LESSON Mark 10:17-27

- <sup>17</sup> As Jesus was setting out on a journey, one man ran up to him and knelt in front of him. He asked, "Good teacher, what must I do to inherit eternal life?"
- <sup>18</sup> Jesus said to him, "Why do you call me good? No one is good except one—God. <sup>19</sup> You know the commandments. 'You shall not murder. You shall not commit adultery. You shall not steal. You shall not give false testimony. You shall not defraud. Honor your father and mother.'"<sup>[a]</sup>
- <sup>20</sup> The man replied, "Teacher, I have kept all these since I was a child."
- <sup>21</sup> Jesus looked at him, loved him, and said to him, "One thing you lack. Go, sell whatever you have, and give to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven. Then come, follow me."
- <sup>22</sup> When he heard this, he looked sad and went away grieving, because he had great wealth. <sup>23</sup> Jesus looked around and said to his disciples, "How hard it will be for those who have riches to enter the kingdom of God!"
- <sup>24</sup> The disciples were amazed at his words. But Jesus told them again, "Children, how hard it is for those who trust in their riches to enter the kingdom of God! <sup>25</sup> It is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle than for a rich man to enter the kingdom of God."
- <sup>26</sup> They were even more astonished and said to one another, "Who then can be saved?"
- <sup>27</sup> Jesus looked at them and said, "For people, it is impossible, but not for God, because all things are possible for God."
