# The Prayer of the Day




#### The Psalm - 2

The kings of the earth take their stand and the rulers gather together against the LORD\* and against his Anointed One.




The One enthroned in heaven laughs;\*

today I have become your Father."


Glory be to the Father and to the Son\* and to the Holy Spirit, as it was in the beginning,\* is now, and will be forever. Amen.



THE SECOND LESSON Romans 8:18-25

<sup>18</sup> For I conclude that our sufferings at the present time are not worth comparing with the glory that is going to be revealed to us. <sup>19</sup> In fact, creation is waiting with eager longing for the sons of God to be revealed. <sup>20</sup> For creation was subjected to futility, not by its own will, but by the will of the one who subjected it, in the hope <sup>21</sup> that even creation itself will be set free from slavery to corruption, in order to share in the glorious freedom of the children of God. <sup>22</sup> For we know that all of creation is groaning with birth pains right up to the present time. <sup>23</sup> And not only creation, but also we ourselves, who have the firstfruits of the Spirit, groan inwardly while we eagerly await our adoption as sons, the redemption of our body. <sup>24</sup> Indeed, it was for this hope we were saved. But hope that is seen is not hope, because who hopes for what he already sees? <sup>25</sup> But if we hope for something we do not see, we eagerly wait for it with patient endurance.

Alleluia. In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth. Alleluia.



GOSPEL John 1:1-18

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. <sup>2</sup> He was with God in the beginning. <sup>3</sup> Through him everything was made, and without him not one thing was made that has been made. <sup>4</sup> In him was life, and the life was the light of mankind. <sup>5</sup> The light is shining in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it.

- <sup>6</sup> There was a man, sent from God, whose name was John. <sup>7</sup> He came as an eyewitness to testify about the light so that everyone would believe through him. <sup>8</sup> He was not the light, but he came to testify about the light.
- <sup>9</sup> The real light that shines on everyone was coming into the world. <sup>10</sup> He was in the world, and the world was made through him, yet the world did not recognize him. <sup>11</sup> He came to what was his own, yet his own people did not accept him. <sup>12</sup> But to all who did receive him, to those who believe in his name, he gave the right to become children of God. <sup>13</sup> They were born, not of blood, or of the desire of the flesh, or of a husband's will, but born of God.
- <sup>14</sup> The Word became flesh and dwelled among us. We have seen his glory, the glory he has as the only-begotten from the Father, full of grace and truth.
- <sup>15</sup> John testified about him. He cried out, "This was the one I spoke about when I said, 'The one coming after me outranks me because he existed before me." <sup>16</sup> For out of his fullness we have all received grace upon grace. <sup>17</sup> For the law was given through Moses; grace and truth came through Jesus Christ. <sup>18</sup> No one has ever seen God. The only-begotten Son, who is close to the Father's side, has made him known.
