CONFESSION & ABSOLUTION

- M: The use of the Ministry of the Keys is that special power and right which Christ gave to his church on earth, to forgive the sins of penitent sinners but to refuse forgiveness to the impenitent as long as they do not repent.
- C: The holy Evangelist John writes in chapter 20, "Jesus breathed on his disciples and said, 'Receive the Holy Spirit. If you forgive anyone his sins, they are forgiven; if you do not forgive them, they are not forgiven."

HYMN

CW21 - BLUE #656 (1,2): "As Surely as I Live, God Said"

"As surely as I live," God said,
"I would not have the sinner dead,
But that he turn from error's ways,
Repent, and live through endless days."

To us, therefore, Christ gave command: "Go forth and preach in ev'ry land; Bestow on all my pard'ning grace Who will repent of sinful ways.

- M: A Christian congregation with its called servant of Christ uses the Keys in accordance with Christ's command by forgiving those who repent of their sin and are willing to amend, and by excluding from the congregation those who are plainly impenitent that they may repent. We believe that, when this is done, it is as valid and certain in heaven also, as if Christ, our dear Lord, dealt with us himself.
- C: Jesus says in Matthew, chapter 18, "If your brother or sister sins, go and point out their fault, just between the two of you. If they listen to you, you have won them over.
- M: But if they will not listen, take one or two others along, so that 'every matter may be established by the testimony of two or three witnesses.' ¹⁷ If they still refuse to listen, tell it to the church; and if they refuse to listen even to the church, treat them as you would a pagan or a tax collector.
- C: "Truly I tell you, whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven.

HYMN

CW21 - BLUE #656 (3,4): "As Surely as I Live, God Said"

"All those whose sins you thus remit I truly pardon and acquit, And those whose sins you do retain Condemned and guilty shall remain.

"What you will bind, that bound shall be; What you will loose, that shall be free; Unto my Church the keys are giv'n To op'n and close the gates of heav'n.

- M: Confession has two parts. The one is that we confess our sins; the other, that we receive absolution or forgiveness from the pastor as from God himself, not doubting but firmly believing that our sins are thus forgiven before God in heaven.
- C: Before God we should plead guilty of all sins, even those we are not aware of.
- M: Consider your place in life according to the Ten Commandments. Are you a father, mother, son, daughter, employer or employee? Have you been disobedient, unfaithful, or lazy? Have you hurt anyone by word or deed? Have you been dishonest, careless, wasteful, or done other wrong?

C: Holy and merciful Father, I confess that I am by nature sinful and that I have disobeyed you in my thoughts, words, and actions. I have done what is evil and failed to do what is good. For this I deserve your punishment both now and in eternity. But I am truly sorry for my sins, and trusting in my Savior Jesus Christ, I pray: Lord, have mercy on me, a sinner.

CW21 - BLUE #656 (5,6): "As Surely as I Live, God Said"

The words which absolution give Are his who died that we might live; The minister whom Christ has sent Is but his humble instrument.

When ministers lay on their hands, Absolved by Christ the sinner stands; He who by grace the Word believes Forgiveness, sure and sweet, receives.

M: God, our heavenly Father, has been merciful to us and has given his only Son to be the atoning sacrifice for our sins. Therefore, as a called servant of Christ and by his authority, I forgive you all you sins in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.

<u>SERMON</u> Genesis 45:1-8,14-15

Joseph was unable to control himself in front of all his attendants, so he called out, "Send everyone out from my presence!" When no one else was left with him, Joseph revealed himself to his brothers. 2 He wept out loud. The Egyptians heard him, and the house of Pharaoh heard about it. 3 Joseph said to his brothers, "I am Joseph! Is my father still alive?"

His brothers could not answer him, because they were terrified by his presence. 4 Joseph said to his brothers, "Come closer to me, please."

They came closer. He said, "I am Joseph, your brother, whom you sold into Egypt. 5 Now do not be upset or angry with yourselves for selling me to this place, since God sent me ahead of you to preserve life. 6 For two years now the famine has been in the land, and there are still five more years in which there will be neither plowing nor harvest. 7 God sent me ahead of you to preserve you as survivors on the earth, and to keep you alive by a great act of deliverance. 8 So it was not you who sent me here, but God, and he has made me a father to Pharaoh, lord over his entire household, and ruler over the whole land of Egypt.


THE BENEDICTION
