When the parents brought in the child Jesus to do for him what was customary according to the law, ²⁸ Simeon took him into his arms and praised God. He said, ²⁹ Lord, you now dismiss your servant in peace, according to your word,30 because my eyes have seen your salvation, 31 which you have prepared before the face of all people, ³² a light for revelation to the Gentiles, and the glory of your people Israel.³³ Joseph and the child's mother were amazed at the things that were spoken about him.

I'm a member of Lamb of God Lutheran Church in Madison, Alabama and during the last thirteen years I've been on many musical tours, playing for worship and concerts at over 775 WELS and ELS churches in 41 states from Fairbanks, Alaska to Cape Coral, Florida. My songs are all original Christian music and I love to tell the story of the Spirit's powerful work in my stubborn and unbelieving heart.

I played music professionally for 30 years on the west coast. I was an atheist until age 33, and after that sort of a new-age spiritualist. 9 years later I became a Lutheran and a Christian at the same time in 1995. I've been writing Christian songs for the last 14 years, including a song about my personal experience with hurricane Katrina. I have Christian CDs available: "Lifted" in 2006 and 2007, "Feed Your Faith" in 2008, "On the Road for Jesus," a compilation of two earlier recordings, "One Cross, Three Nails" done in July 2012, "Jesus Wins!" December 2016 and my new one "Hymns With Friends" finished September 2018.
