

We will meet on Aug 16 at 10-12. The focus of our meeting will be to clean our kitchen with a brief business meeting!




Please plan on joining us after worship on Sundays starting September 11th for Bible Class and Sunday for every age!

OPPORTUNITES TO GIVE OUR BEST




We are asking you to prayerfully consider how you can give your best to the Lord to support the gospel ministry at Grace.
