IMPORTANT INFORMATION regarding Tuition at Grace:

- 1 The registration fee is charged to all students and is non-refundable. The registration fees for all currently enrolled students are due at the time of their re-enrollment for 2021-2020. All new student registration fees are due with their application.
- 2 Grace Lutheran School requires all families to use GradeLink, a tuition, grading, and administration online service. More information on this service is provided in separate documentation.
- 3 Financial assistance for the 2021-2022 school year will be determined on an "as needed and available" basis. All families seeking financial aid are required to re-apply each school year. All applications for financial aid must be submitted beginning March 22nd, 2021, and not later than April 30th, 2021. Families requesting financial aid by this deadline will be notified of the amount available to them by June 30th, 2021. Grace expects and encourages families to prayerfully consider scriptural stewardship in seeking a Christian education for their children at Grace.
- 4 Full year payment of 100% of tuition made on or before October 2nd, 2021, will be discounted by 4%; Financial Aid recipients are NOT eligible for this discount. Payment arrangements are also available Monthly (10 equal parts, Sept-June) or Quarter (Sept, Dec, Mar, June) without discount. Payments are due and payable the 1st of each due month and are considered late on the 5th. A late fee of \$25 will be assessed on the 15th of any month where dues remain unpaid. If you have new and urgent circumstances affecting your ability to pay, you must contact Grace in advance of the due date to discuss options. Failure to make timely payment(s) according to your Tuition Agreement may affect your child(ren)'s enrollment status at Grace.
- 5 The average cost to educate a student in grades K-8 at GLS is \$7,350 per student.
- 6 Grace Lutheran Church member families are strongly encouraged to consider the average cost and estimated tuition figures as they prayerfully consider their personal stewardship.
- 7 Assistance will be provided in filing applications for grants and scholarships to assist reducing tuition payments. All families requesting financial aid are required to apply for grants and scholarships, including seeking financial support from their home church if not attending Grace Lutheran Church.
- 8 All families are asked to provide volunteer hours via our Serving and Laboring Together (SALT) program - details provided separately.
- 9 * There is a one-time charge of \$250.00 for a student's Chromebook. The one-time Chromebook charge for all years applies to upper grade (5-8) students if enrolled at GLS for the first time. The \$250.00 charge is in addition to the Technology Fee.
